



NOMINATIONS RULES

Positions open for election will be announced in the spring ENAO journal (JENAO), on the ENAO website and electronically to all ENAO members by the President according to the ENAO Nominations Policy.

Nomination forms will be available for download on the ENAO website (www.enaome.com)

Nominators and nominees must be current ENAO members in good standing, at the time of the nomination submission and at the time of the subsequent election.

The nominee shall submit written consent for nomination to a position.

No nominations will be taken from the floor at the ENAO AGM.

Complete nomination forms must be received by the Nominations Chair according to ENAO policy.

All positions open for election and the successful candidates will be announced at the Annual General Meeting.

All ENAO elected / acclaimed positions begin immediately following the AGM.

NOMINATIONS POLICY

1. A Call for Nominations will appear in the spring publication of JENAO, will be posted on the ENAO website and will go out electronically to the ENAO membership three (3) months prior to the Annual General Meeting.
2. Completed nomination forms may be submitted by Fax, Email or Canada Post, and must be received by the Nominations Chair six (6) weeks prior to the AGM.
3. An ENAO election announcement and online voting instructions will go out electronically to the ENAO membership, one (1) month prior to the AGM. Online voting will immediately be open for two (2) weeks and will close at 2400 hours on the identified date, two (2) weeks prior to the AGM.
4. The online voting results will be presented to the ENAO Board of Directors by the Nominations Chair, prior to the AGM. The election results will be announced by the ENAO President to the membership during the AGM, will be subsequently posted on the ENAO website and will be announced in the next publication of ENAO.
5. Any ENAO member may submit a written request to the Nominations Chair, for a recount of the online votes, up to thirty (30) days following an ENAO AGM election results announcement.
6. A record of all online votes shall be retained by the Nominations Chair for a period of sixty (60) days following the ENAO AGM election of officers' announcement, and then shall be destroyed.
